Diabetes treatment

*Caring for your diabetic pet may seem like a daunting task but we are here to help you!
There are no silly questions and we will gladly help out at any time of the day.*

Store the insulin in the fridge.

Roll the insulin bottle to mix before injection. DO NOT SHAKE IT.

Using Vetsulin insulin and the 40 unit syringe give ____ units every 12 hours under the skin.

Let _____ eat before giving the insulin and it is ideal to give the injections 10-12 hours apart.

If _____ is tired, weak or not eating call us and give some sugar (Karo syrup, maple syrup or honey) rub some on his/her gums. DO NOT GIVE EXTRA INSULIN WITHOUT A CURRENT BLOOD GLUCOSE TEST.

_____ will be eating a new diet of Hill's Prescription Diet Canine W/D either the canned or dry kibble. We recommend gradually changing the food over the next 7-14 days to help avoid stomach upset.
